Refusal to abide by the Court's order and/or continued disruption of the meeting may result in a Contempt of Court Citation. In order to expedite the flow of business and to provide all citizens the opportunity to speak, the Commissioners Court has imposed a three-minute limitation on persons addressing the Court.




