

How to Sign Up for a COVID-19 Vaccine in Texas



How to Sign Up

- To find a vaccine provider and their sign-up information, go to dshs.texas.gov/covidvaccine.
- People without Internet access can call 2-1-1 for referral to a local vaccine provider.
- Check the provider's website for sign-up information and vaccine availability.
- Call if the website doesn't answer your questions or if you don't have internet.



Where to Sign Up

Large vaccination hub

- Hubs are available across the state and receive a more consistent supply of vaccine.
- You can get a vaccine at any hub, regardless of where you live.

Community vaccine provider

- Community vaccine providers, like pharmacies or your doctor, may have vaccine.
- If there isn't a hub near you, community providers in your area may have vaccine.

Who can get a vaccine:

Front-line healthcare workers

People 65 and older

People 16+ with a health condition that increases risk of severe COVID-19 illness

DON'T JUST SHOW UP



Do not show up at a provider without first signing up or checking the provider's instructions for vaccination.

Remember:

BE PATIENT - SUPPLY IS LIMITED



Vaccine supply is limited. Not every provider has vaccine each week. Hubs may have long waiting lists.

YOUR SECOND DOSE



Please go back to the same provider for your second dose.
