NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON REALIGNING COMMISSIONER PRECINCTS

According to the 2010 Census data, the County's commissioner precincts are not of sufficiently equal population and must be redrawn in order to comply with the "one-person, one-vote" (equal population) principle established by the U.S. Constitution.

The San Jacinto County Commissioners Court is considering new boundaries for its commissioner precincts and wants to hear from you. Tell us what you think about the preliminary commissioner precinct plan at the public hearing described below:

The preliminary plans for the commissioner precincts will be available at the hearing and is available for public inspection during normal business hours at County Judge's Office, Courthouse Coldspring, Texas Monday through Friday from now until the date of the public hearing.

The Guidelines, among other things, require that comments be submitted in writing even if you make them orally at the hearing; all written comments are due by the close of the hearing. The Guidelines may be found at www.co.san-jacinto.tx.us. Any plans that are proposed must conform to the redistricting Criteria adopted by the Commissioners Court.
