



## COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

**WHEREAS**, on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020, the County Judge declared a state of local disaster for San Jacinto County due to the Coronavirus- 2019 (COVID-19), which was extended by the County Commissioner's Court in accordance with the Texas Government Code 418.108; and


**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

**WHEREAS**, the SJC Commissioner's Court met on April 22, 2020 and unanimously voted to extend the declaration of disaster until April 30, 2020 in compliance with the statewide order issued by the Honorable Greg Abbott, Governor of the Great State of Texas; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF SAN JACINTO COUNTY:**

1. That the State of disaster proclaimed for San Jacinto County by the County Judge on 17<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020, is hereby continued until April 30, 2020, or until terminated by order of the COMMISSIONERS COURT.
2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to local authority for emergency measures and shall become effective on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2020.
