ORDER DECLARING BURN BAN

WHEREAS, the County Judge of San Jacinto County has determined that the circumstances present in all or part of the incorporated areas of San Jacinto County, Texas, create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought condition exist within the County; and

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that all outdoor burning is prohibited in the unincorporated areas of the County for not more than 7 days, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioner's Court of San Jacinto County, Texas.

This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commissioner or Environmental Quality for:

1. Firefighter training;
2. Public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations;
3. Planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or,
4. Burns that conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.
5. related to Commercial Food Establishments; and
6. propane and cooking fires under safe and controlled conditions
