



DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of San Jacinto on the 9th day of July, 2024, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people due to inclement weather, loss of electricity due to extreme wind damage due to Tropical Storm Beryl and severe flooding due to recent rainfall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF SAN JACINTO COUNTY;

WHEREAS, several County and State highways are inundated with water due to extreme rainfall and extraordinary measures are necessary to alleviate people's suffering; and

WHEREAS, as of July 8, 2024, there are more than 10 confirmed cases of flooded roadways throughout San Jacinto County; and


WHEREAS, approximately 90% of the County's residence are without power as a result of severe damages to the electrical utility infrastructure through the County; and

NOW THEREFORE I, FRITZ FAULKNER, COUNTY JUDGE of San Jacinto County, do hereby certify that excessive rainfall, flooding and loss of power poses an imminent threat of disaster. In accordance with the authority vested in me, I hereby declare a state of disaster for San Jacinto County, Texas.
