AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026**


**BE IT ORDAINED AND ORDERED** by the Commissioners Court of San Jacinto County, Texas that:


We, The Commissioners Court of San Jacinto County, Texas do hereby levy or adopt the tax rate of \$100 valuation for this Fiscal Year of 2026 beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026 as follows:

<b>.48291</b>	<b>Total Rate</b>


The Tax-Assessor/Collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of San Jacinto County, Texas employing the above rate.


