

DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of San Jacinto on the 20th day September 2019, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from:


TROPICAL STORM IMELDA

WHEREAS, the County Judge of San Jacinto County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF SAN JACINTO COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the County of San Jacinto pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of San Jacinto County.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the county Emergency Management Plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
