Recently San Jacinto County was included in the Presidential Disaster Declaration for the Tropical Storm Imelda event. As a result of this, we will have teams from FEMA to assist our residents.

A Disaster Recovery Center will open Tuesday, Oct. 29, in Cleveland to help disaster survivors affected by Tropical Storm Imelda.

Recovery specialists from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the U.S. Small Business Administration, state and federal agencies will be at the center to answer questions about disaster assistance and low-interest disaster loans. They can also help survivors apply for federal disaster assistance.

The Center location and hours are: Cleveland Senior Citizens Organization, 220 Peach Ave., Cleveland, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., seven days a week (until further notice).

Effective October 29, 2019 The FEMA DSA (Disaster Survivor Assistance) Team will be in the County going door to door in the Imelda Storm affected areas.
