This time is provided for citizens to address Commissioners Court about items that are on the court agenda. Citizens should complete a witness form located on the side table. Pursuant to State Open Meetings Law, the Commissioners Court is restricted in discussing or taking action on items not posted on the agenda. Those members of the public who are inappropriately attired and/or who do not conduct themselves in an orderly and appropriate manner will be ordered to leave the meeting. Refusal to abide by the Court's order and/or continued disruption of the meeting may result in a Contempt of Court Citation. In order to expedite the flow of business and to provide all citizens the opportunity to speak, the Commissioners Court has imposed a three-minute limitation on persons addressing the Court.

NEW BUSINESS: PUBLIC HEARING

1. The County of San Jacinto will hold a public hearing at 5:05 p.m. on Thursday, August 15, 2024, at the San Jacinto County Courthouse, County Courtroom, located at 1 State Highway 150 in Coldspring, Texas regarding an amendment to the County's Texas Community Development Block Grant contract CDV21-0367. The purpose of this meeting is to allow citizens an opportunity to discuss the changes to the original project scope which reduces the length of the road project. The change also reduces the number of beneficiaries of the project. The County encourages citizens to participate in the discussion of this amendment and to make their views known at this public hearing. Citizens unable to attend this meeting may submit their comments to Fritz Faulkner, County Judge, at the County Courthouse. Persons with disabilities that wish to attend this meeting should contact the County Courthouse to arrange for assistance. Individuals who require auxiliary aids or services for this meeting should contact the County Courthouse at least two days before the meeting so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
