San Jacinto County is currently coordinating the countywide update of the San Jacinto County Hazard Mitigation Plan, which includes participation from the cities of Coldspring, Point Blank, and Shepherd.

A Hazard Mitigation Plan outlines actions that can be taken to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property from natural hazards. It is an effective tool for identifying risks and vulnerabilities to natural hazards so that communities can take action before disaster occurs. Plans are required to receive federal mitigation grant funding for projects and must be updated every five years.
