The County of San Jacinto County CDV23-0314 will receive bids for PB & SC Water Supply Corporation to construct one (1) new well including drilling, installation of approximately eight hundred fifty vertical feet (850 VF) of casing, column piping, one (1) submersible pump, concrete well head, electrical improvements and controls, related instrumentation, yard piping, driveway and security fencing and all associated appurtenances until 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 10, 2025 at the 1 State Hwy 150, RM 2, Coldspring, TX 77331, County Clerk's Office. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 10, 2025 at the San Jacinto County Commissioner's Court at The Shelter located at 255 Live Oak, Coldspring, TX 77331.

A certified check or bank draft payable to San Jacinto County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

San Jacinto County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by San Jacinto County for a period not to exceed 30 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
